



Continuous Emissions Monitoring Systems (CEMS) Field Technician:

In the role of ***CEMS Field Technician***, the candidate will be responsible for field support of Continuous Emissions Monitoring Systems (CEMS) projects. Activities required to support CEMS projects include responsible deployment of CEMS trailers and equipment to oil and gas production facilities which may be remote or in difficult-to-access areas, coordinating with client personnel regarding site access, power availability, and other operational aspects including technical equipment installation, and deploying the CEMS equipment. CEMS equipment set-up requires lifting up to 40 lbs., working with tools, connecting camera feeds to a server (wiring), and ensuring that the overall rig is soundly and correctly assembled. This role will require self-motivation, working in hot and/or cold weather conditions and independent thinking to troubleshoot logistics, equipment issues, and to ensure equipment is safely deployed per client requirements. **Must be willing to travel up to 80%.**

Requirements

- Must have a high school diploma, general education development (GED), or equivalent (military service and/or technical degrees preferred);
- 2-4 years field experience regarding technical, industrial, and/or oil and gas services (preferred);
- Software, programming, networking, or electrical skills preferred;
- Proficient with Microsoft applications (Outlook, Excel, Word, etc.);
- Willing to travel to remote oil and gas locations throughout the geographic project area;
- Must have a valid Driver's License and clean driving record;
- Must be able to work alone;
- Excellent analytical and communication skills;
- Must be task-oriented with the ability to maintain tight schedules; and
- Must have Occupational Safety & Health Administration (OSHA) 40-hr Hazardous Waste Operations and Emergency Response (HAZWOPER) Training, PEC Safety (SafeLand USA) training, or equivalent (Encino will subsidize training gaps).
